TRON Generation. respects your concerns about privacy. This Privacy Policy applies to information we collect through our Website and services. This Privacy Policy describes the types of information we collect or receive, how we may use that information and how such information are protected as required by the EU General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR)

By using our Website and services you agree to our collection and use of information as described here.

The information we collect includes personal information and non-personal information, as such terms are defined below.

The Privacy Policy also describes the measures we take to protect the security of the personal information. We also tell you how you can reach us to ask us to (i) access, change or not use the personal information you have provided to us, (ii) withdraw any consent you previously provided to us, and (iii) answer any questions you may have about our privacy practices.

- Our Collection and Use of Personal Information

Personal information is data that can be used to uniquely identify or contact a single person. You may choose to provide personal information to us when you use our Website or Services. Because we change our offerings and features from time to time, the options you have to provide us with personal information also may change, but here are some examples of situations in which you may decide to provide personal information to us:

- Registering with our Website
- Creating an online account
- Completing a survey
- Contacting us for any reason, such as by email, including for technical support or customer service
- Using our Website or online services when personal information is required for use or participation

The personal information we collect from you will vary depending on the service you are using, the site you are visiting, and how you access it. However, the personal information you provide

generally may include email address, phone number (which may include mobile phone number), and postal address.

Because we directly ask you to provide personal information in these cases, you often will be able to tell from our specific requests what types of information we receive from you.

We collect this information for reasons such as:

- To provide you with access to the site, service or feature you requested
- To provide you with technical support or customer service
- To communicate with you, respond to your requests, or provide you with updates and information
- To manage your account
- To better understand our users, their interests and their preferences
- To develop, deliver, and improve our products, services, and other offerings

- Our Collection and Use of Non-Personal Information

We also collect non-personal information – data in a form that does not permit direct association with any specific individual. We may collect, use and process non-personal information for service improving purposes. For example, when you use our services, we may collect data from and about the “commercial electronic mail messages” and “transactional or relationship messages” (as such terms are defined in the CAN-SPAM Act (15 U.S.C. 7702 et. seq.) that are sent to your email accounts. We collect such commercial transactional messages so that we can better understand the behavior of the senders of such messages, and better understand new spam techniques to improve our products and services.

- Information Collected by Automated Means

We may obtain certain personal and non-personal information by automated means when you visit our sites. The type of information we collect by automated means may vary, but generally includes technical information about your device, such as IP address or other device identifier. The information we collect also may include usage information and statistics about your interaction with our Website. That information may include the URLs of our web pages that you visited, URLs of referring and exiting pages, page views, time spent on a page, number of clicks, platform type, and other information about how you used our Website.

In cases where you use a mobile device to access our sites, we will receive information about the location of your device. In some cases, even if you are not using a mobile device,

information about your general location may be discernable from your device's IP address or the URLs we receive. If you access or use our sites or services with your mobile telephone, we may collect your telephone number.

We use information we collect by automated means to understand our users and to determine their preferences. As a result, we can develop and deliver new or modified offerings, that are improved with our users' preferences in mind.

Here are some of the types of automated data collection that may occur when you use our sites:

- Web Browsers

When you visit one of our Website, your browser automatically sends us your Internet protocol ("IP") address so that the web pages you request can be sent to your computer or device. We use your IP address to determine additional information, such as whether the computer or device has ever been used to visit our site before, which site features were used most often, and how much time was spent on a page.

- Cookies

We may automatically collect information through "cookies," which are text files placed on your device's hard drive when you visit Website. Cookies may enhance your online experience by saving your preferences while you are visiting a particular site. We use cookies, for example, for authentication purposes, to measure session activity on the site, and to determine which areas and features of the site are the most popular. Most browsers will tell you how to stop accepting new cookies, how to be notified when you receive a new cookie, and how to disable existing cookies. Without cookies, however, you may not be able to take full advantage of all our site features. We treat information collected by cookies and other technologies as non-personal information. However, to the extent that Internet Protocol (IP) addresses or similar identifiers are considered personal information by local law, we also treat these identifiers as personal information. Similarly, to the extent that non-personal information is combined with personal information, we treat the combined information as personal information for the purposes of this Privacy Policy.

- WE Do Not Track Browser Signals.

At this time, the TRON Generation Website and services do not recognize automated browser signals regarding tracking mechanisms, which may include "do not track" instructions. However, you may be able to change your privacy preferences regarding the use of cookies and similar technologies through your browser, as described above.

- Sharing of Information

We do not share personal information, however we may disclose information about you (i) if we are required to do so by law or legal process, (ii) to law enforcement authorities or other government officials. We also reserve the right to transfer personal information we have about you in the event we sell or transfer all or a portion of our business or assets.

- Your Choices

In certain cases, you may have choices about how we use and disclose your personal information. For example, we will ask you before we use your personal information for any purpose incompatible with those purposes identified in this Policy.

You can also choose not to give us the information we request, as described in the “Information You Provide to Us” section of this Policy. In some cases, if you decide not to provide information, we will not be able to provide you with access to the site you requested, or we may not be able to provide you with the service, feature or information you requested.

In some cases, you can stop or limit the information we collect by automated means. Please review the sections of this Policy titled “Information Collected by Automated Means” to learn more about how you may be able to stop or limit our receipt of that information.

You may also exercise and amend your choices by sending an email to us as specified in the “How to Contact Us” section below.

- Access and Correction

We will provide you with the ability to access and update certain information we have about you, such as your email information. Please submit your request by sending an email to the address specified in the “How to Contact Us” section below. Please include your name, email address and postal address in your request so that we may respond appropriately and promptly.

- How We Protect Personal Information

We have implemented measures designed to secure your personal information from accidental loss and from unauthorized access, use, alteration and disclosure. All information you provide to us is stored on secure servers behind firewalls.

The safety and security of your information also depends on you. Where we have given you (or where you have chosen) a password for access to certain parts of our Website, you are responsible for keeping this password confidential. We ask you not to share your password with anyone. We urge you to be careful about giving out information in public areas . The information you share in public areas may be viewed by anyone.

Once we have received your information, we will use strict procedures and security features to try to prevent unauthorized access.

- Links to Other Sites

Our Website provide links to other websites. We do not control, and are not responsible for, the content or practices of these other websites. Our provision of such links does not constitute our endorsement of these other websites, their content, their owners, or their practices. This Privacy Policy does not apply to these other websites, which are subject to any privacy and other policies they may have. You should use caution and review the privacy policies of any web sites, services or third party providers that you visit from our Website or our products to learn more about their information practices, which may be significantly different from ours

- Children's Privacy

TRON Generation does not direct its Website to children, and we do not knowingly collect personal information from children. If we become aware that we have inadvertently received personal information from a user who is under the age of thirteen, we will delete the information from our records.

- Transfers of Information

As part of our international operations, we may transfer information about you to any jurisdiction where we do business. Even if those jurisdictions do not have the same privacy laws as the jurisdiction where you reside, we will treat your information as subject to the protections described in this Policy.

If you are visiting from the European Union or other regions with laws governing data collection and use, please note that you are agreeing to the transfer of your personal information to the United Kingdom by TRON Generation. By providing your personal information you consent to any transfer and processing in accordance with this Policy.

- Updates to Our Privacy Policy

This Privacy Policy may be updated periodically to you to reflect changes in our information practices or relevant laws. We will indicate at the top of the Policy when it was updated. Please review this Policy any time you access or use our sites to make sure you have reviewed the most recent version.
